You are allowed to enter up to 10 items.

HUNTER CATEGORIES:

This is for those who harvested their trophies and have had someone mount for them.

Birds- Water fowl, turkey tails, etc.

Deer Head- Head mounts, euro mounts, horns/antlers

Pelts/Rugs- Any animal (must have loop or some indication on how to hang)

Open/Other- Let's see what you got, as long as it can hang on the wall.

TAXIDERMIST/CREATOR CATEGORIES:

This is for taxidermists themselves who have created the mount/pelt.

Professional Open- Let's see what you have, as long as it can hang on the wall.

Amateur Open- Let's see what you have, as long as it can hang on the wall.

Please mark with tape on the back side of your mount with your name and phone number.

Pelts/rugs, please put a tag with your name and phone number.

On the form, please describe your entry, size, and what is needed for us to mount it on the wall.

All entries must be able to hang on the wall. No pedestal mounts.

All entries must be an animal you have harvested or if you are the taxidermist of.

NOTE: Please ensure all entries show no signs of mold and/or insects before entry. Please ensure all entries have the proper tags if tags are required by law. Inspect all entries for damage.

No Judge, Superintendent, or any paid employees of the Taxidermy Department will be eligible to display or design for competition in this department.
